QUICK REFERENCE: GETTING TO EASA2022

EASA2022 takes place at Queen's University Belfast

For details on how to reach Belfast, look at <u>our travel page</u> and the <u>low-carbon route page</u>. Remember to buy comprehensive travel insurance covering any losses arising from problems with flights, COVID or weather etc.

If you are one of the unfortunates whose flights have been cancelled due to current aviation chaos, we recommend looking for alternatives to direct flights to Belfast: consider flying to Dublin and taking the <u>AirCoach bus from Dublin Airport</u> to Belfast (operates 24/7 and the ride's <2hrs). You can also come by train from Dublin - get a bus to the centre, then the train from Connelly station. If you need to take a taxi at the Dublin airport and the taxi line seems to stretch on well into the Atlantic Ocean, download the Free Now taxi app (N.B. Uber does not operate in Dublin) and walk to the Zone 18 parking space opposite Terminal 1 - you should get a ride in a few minutes.

Alternatively, fly to Liverpool <u>and catch the ferry to Belfast</u> (8hrs) or, if you don't mind a more adventurous route, fly to Scotland (Glasgow, Edinburgh), bus from the airport and then ferry from Stranraer (see the option <u>here</u>).

If you have managed to fly to Belfast, take **Intercity bus 300a** to Europa Buscentre. From there it is a 20 min walk to the campus: exit the bus station on Glengall Street, turn right to Great Victoria Street, then keep walking straight, it's about a 1.5 km to the Reception Desk at the South Dining Hall.

When walking from the centre towards the University quarter, you'll see signposts on many street corners: follow arrows towards QUB Lanyon building (not to be confused with the local railway station, Lanyon Place), or Ulster Museum or the Botanic Gardens.

If you have luggage and prefer to use public transport, go to Great Victoria St to take the bus from Great Northern Mall, for example 7b, for about four stops to College Green, then walk west on College Park toward Botanic Ave, turn right onto Botanic Ave, turn left into University Square.

Uber works in Belfast, as do the local fonaCAB app and Valuecabs app (see below).

If you are coming from the train station:

Walking (~26mins)

- Walk west on East Bridge St/A20 towards Stewart St, continue to follow East Bridge St.
- Slight left onto East Bridge St/A24, continue to follow A24
- Turn right onto Donegall Pass
- Turn left onto Posnett St
- Turn right to stay on Posnett St
- Turn left onto Botanic Ave
- Turn right onto University Square destination will be on the right

Public Transport (~7mins)

- From Layton Place take the train to **Botanic**, Stop ID: CL
- Coming out of Botanic, head south on Botanic Ave toward Cameron St
- Turn right onto University Square Destination will be on the right

Public Transport in Belfast

Bus

The nearest stop to the venue is College Green. Translink is Northern Ireland's public transport provider. Metro and Glider services operate in the Belfast area, with Ulsterbus and Goldline bus services connecting the rest of Northern Ireland. You can purchase pre-paid tickets on the <u>mLink ticketing app</u>, or directly on board with the driver.

CONFERENCE VENUE: Queen's University Belfast

The main conference venue is the central cluster of buildings on the Queen's University Belfast main campus: South Dining Hall, Lanyon Building, Peter Froggat Centre etc. See the map at the end of this document. Accessibility details/maps of the venue are here.

The **Reception desk** is located in the **South Dining Hall (89 University Rd, Belfast BT9 6BD)** and will be open Tuesday 09:00-18:00, Wednesday 08:00-17:00, Thursday 08:00-17:00 and Friday 08:00-14:30.

If your panel is on Tuesday, please make sure you come in early enough (between 09:00 and 11:00) to get checked in before you need to go find your panel room! If your panel is on another day, the best time to come to check in is during the first two panel sessions on Tuesday.

The NomadIT EASA2022 **conference office** is located in the **Old Staff Common Room on the corner of the Lanyon Building**, and will be staffed throughout the conference. If you owe money, please come straight there, as there is no point standing in the Reception desk line just to be sent away to the Old Staff Common Room. **Bring the money in cash (pounds) as we cannot take card payments.**

The Keynote lecture on the opening day as well as all plenaries, Wednesday's Ukraine roundtable and the AGM will take place in Whitla Hall which is adjacent to the South Dining Hall; panels, labs and roundtables are in the rooms stated <u>in the timetable</u>.

Panel rooms are in a cluster of close-together buildings at the centre of the campus: **Peter Froggatt Centre (most panels), Lanyon Building, Music Building, Physics Buildings, College Park, Mathematics & Physics Teaching Centre, Main Site Tower and University Square.** The <u>Film Programme</u> screenings are in the **Queen's Film Theatre (20 University Square, Belfast BT7 1PA)**. Some labs take place in the **The Sonic Laboratory** at the Sonic Arts Research Centre (SARC) (Cloreen Park, Belfast BT9 5HN)

TUESDAY 26 WELCOME DRINKS RECEPTION, 19:15-21:15 St George's Market (East Bridge St, Belfast BT1 3NQ) - <u>map</u>

Once the welcome ceremony and keynote are over, delegates are invited to walk together from the campus to <u>St George's Market</u>, conveniently located in Belfast City Centre, close to the River Lagan and the ICC. It's a 15 minute walk, or 20 if you keep arguing with each other about the keynote. At St George's market we'll raise glasses (and a couple of canapes) to our long-awaited face-to-face reunion! There will be wine, Irish music and dance, and your own good company to enjoy.

Please note there will be no ticket exchange going on, nor will you be able to sell the ticket back, as the existing numbers have all been paid for already.

What to do when you have arrived?
