

## Europeanist Network: Report of Activities in 2014

### EASA 2014 Conference in Tallinn:

Two panels were convened and took place under the umbrella of the Europeanist Network, on the occasion of the last EASA conference: P059 “Topics in the social history of anthropology”; and P004 “Tourism in (post)socialist Eastern Europe”.

Moreover, there was the impromptu initiative to summon an off programme debate under the label “Urgent Anthropology” on the theme: “Reflections on the South Sudan and Ukraine Civil Conflicts. Scholarly, ethical and deontological implications for anthropologists’ professional practice”. Where Andrés Barrera acted as moderator, and presentations were delivered by Abdullahi Osman El-Tom, Günther Schlee and Chris Hann. Vivid open debate originated among participants, presenters and the public alike, on the topics under discussion. This is a new format which may be adopted in the programme of future EASA conferences.

### Book Series with Berghahn Publishers:

Currently there are three manuscripts under review for publication in the series at Berghahn: *“European Anthropologies. The intertwinement of intellectual traditions”*; an edited volume by Andrés Barrera, Monica Heintz and Anna Horolets. *“ ‘Little-Middles’ and their France. The politics of class mobility and immigration in a suburban housing development”*; a volume co-authored by Marie Cartier, Isabelle Coutant, Olivier Masclet, and Yasmine Siblot. And Aimar Ventsel’s monograph *“Punks and Skins United. Identity, Class and the Economics of an East German Subculture”*.

Hopefully all three books would be out sometime along the present fiscal year, or the coming academic year at the latest!
