Europeanist Network: Report of Activities in 2016

The Europeanist network convened its official panel meeting at the last EASA16 conference held in Milano in July 2016.

The ordinary business meeting of the Europeanist network took place on Thursday the 21st. In this meeting participants discussed about the activities and projects planned for the immediate future. In the course of the meeting confirmation came that the volume on *European Anthropologies* will be out in print by mid 2017. It will be published by Berghahn in the framework of the Europeanist network's book series. Two other volumes in the series are in the final stages of review, and hopefully will also be published in the course of 2017.

The issue of the re-establishment of a History of Anthropology Network within EASA was discussed. In weighing up whether this could be done via the setting up of a sub-section within the Europeanist network, or as an independent network of its own, there was agreement that an application be submitted to the EASA's executive committee for the establishment of a new independent network with the said proper name. Moreover, a decision was made, by taking a formal vote from the people present at the meeting, to appoint Lorena Anton, Marie Curie-CIG Fellow at the University of Bucharest, as the new chair of the Europeanist network.
